Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your child recently signed up to be a camper at Young Life's Frontier Ranch, a property that is licensed by the Colorado Department of Human Services. The license indicates that the program has met the required standards for the operation of a childcare facility. If you wish to do so, you may ask to see the license and the last facility inspection.

As a licensed facility, Frontier Ranch makes every effort to provide a safe and healthy environment for adolescents. As part of the licensing provisions, Colorado Law requires that child care providers report all known or suspected cases of child abuse or neglect. If you believe that your child has been the victim of abuse, you should seek immediate assistance from the Chaffee County Department of Social Services. The telephone number is 719-395-0344.
