

# Physician Signature Waiver Information FOR PARENTS

Parents & Guardians,

For the summer of 2019, Crooked Creek Ranch and Frontier Ranch will only require a physician signature for some of our high school campers. It is our hope that this will make sending your child to camp easier!

Which high school students (those who have already completed 9<sup>th</sup> grade at time of camp trip) need a physician signature at Crooked Creek Ranch & Frontier Ranch?

- Has any diagnosed developmental or medical condition of the blood, neurologic, heart, respiratory, or metabolic system, including, but not limited to: seizures, diabetes, sickle cell disease, heart or respiratory conditions, and physical disabilities
- Has any diagnosed medical condition which requires the camper to carry an inhaler, EpiPen, or other emergency medication at all times
- Has asthma
- Has any severe allergy that requires medical intervention after exposure
- Is pregnant or gave birth less than 12 weeks before the first date of camp

For those using the online health form:

- Complete the entire online form ([healthform.younglife.org](http://healthform.younglife.org)) and press submit.
- If your child does not have any medical condition listed above, then you're done! Their camper health form will be sufficiently complete in the AWAITING PHYSICIAN SIGNATURE status.
- If your child has any medical condition listed above, they must obtain a physician signature on the Young Life form prior to attending camp. Once the form is faxed in, the health form will be complete.
- Even if you qualify for the waiver you may receive system generated notifications reminding you to upload a physician signature you can ignore those notifications.

For those using the paper health form:

- Complete the entire form.
- The physician signature section can be found on page 1 in the Health Care Recommendations box.
- If your child has any medical condition listed above, please take the Young Life Health & Consent form with you to the doctor's office. Attached physicals or other documentation do not suffice.
